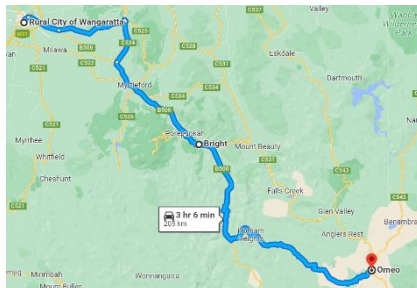
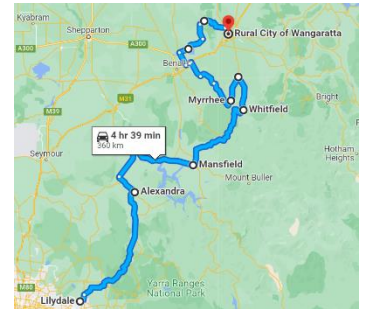


Monday 27th March to Saturday 1st April

The [2023 Alfisti Autumn Tour](#) will run from **Lilydale** on Monday 27th to **Canberra** on Friday 31st March. On Saturday 1st April there will be an optional Tour of Canberra's scenic vistas. The Tour offers six days of touring through Victoria's High Country and the Snowy Mountains. If iconic locations, fabulous roads and sensational scenery together with good food and Alfisti camaraderie tick boxes for you, then don't risk being left behind. The Tour itinerary, as at 28/01/23, is as follows:

Day 1 | Monday 27th March: Lilydale to Wangaratta

Depart **Lilydale @ 9:00am sharp** via the Black Spur to Alexandra for morning tea, then via Mansfield to Whitfield for lunch. After lunch follow the King Valley, through Myrrhee to the [Winton Wetlands](#), then via the Warby Ranges to **Wangaratta**.



Day 2 | Tuesday 28th March: Wangaratta to Omeo

From Wangaratta, travel via Eldorado, Beechworth and Yackandandah (morning tea), then via Myrtleford to Bright for lunch. A steady climb then takes us via Harrietville, through Hotham Heights and Dinner Plain to **Omeo**.



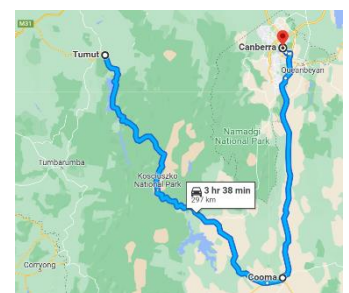
Day 3 | Wednesday 29th March: Omeo to Albury

From Omeo we will follow the Omeo Highway through Anglers Rest (photo op?) and on to Mitta Mitta for lunch. Then via Granya Gap, Bellbridge and Lake Hume to **Albury**.



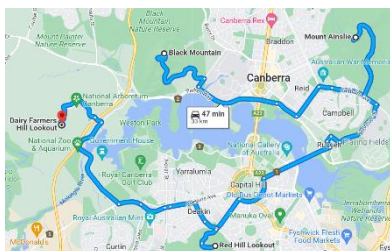
Day 4 | Thursday 30th March: Albury to Tumut

Gather for breakfast in Noreuil Park before the Tour heads out of Albury following the Murray River Road to Jingellic then north to Courabyra (near Tumbarumba) for lunch. Following lunch the Tour heads via Batlow to **Tumut** with an optional detour to the [Adelong Falls Historic Gold Mill Ruins](#) en route.



Day 5 | Friday 31st March: Tumut to Canberra

The Tour heads down the Snowy Mountains Highway via Kiandra and Adaminaby to Cooma for lunch. After lunch the Tour will visit the recently opened [Cooma Car Club Museum](#), before heading on to **Canberra**.



Day 6 | Saturday 1st April: Giro de quattro picchi

This is an optional extra for the Tour which visits Canberra's scenic lookouts prior to lunch at the National Arboretum. The afternoon is free.
